Resolution of Council, the 28th day of June 1999, pursuant to clause 16 of the Institute Constitution.

It is necessary and expedient for the proper management and control of the Institute, the effective exercise of the powers conferred on the Council and the proper performance of its duties and functions, that the Council's powers, duties and functions be delegated to a Council Committee so that urgent matters can be dealt with between Council meetings.

This delegation is valid from the date approved by Council until such time as amended or revoked by Council resolution.

By this Instrument, the Council delegates to its President's Committee its powers, duties and functions.

The President's Committee will report to Council on the exercise of this delegation.
